JIIA Webinar

The implications of Russia's invasion of Ukraine for Europe, Asia, and the international order

The purpose of this event is to present the current security situation in Eastern Europe amid continuing war in Ukraine, along with its broader implications for Europe, Asia, and the international order.

The webinar will feature speeches by speakers from the Embassy of Poland, the Embassy of Ukraine, the Embassy of the United States, and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan, followed by a panel discussion by experts. Mr. Marek Menkiszak, Head of the Russian Department, Centre for Eastern Studies (OSW), will review the security situation in Eastern Europe and its implications for Poland, while Prof. Mataka Kamiya, National Defense Academy, will analyze Japan's perception of its security after Russia invaded Ukraine. Then Prof. Chisako Masuo from Kyushu University discusses China's continued maritime expansion in the Indo-Pacific. The Vice President of Tama University's Center for Rulemaking and Strategy (CRS) will discuss the impact of Russia's actions on U.S. security interests in Europe and the Indo-Pacific.

This event is co-organized by the Embassy of Poland, the Embassy of Ukraine, the Centre for Eastern Studies (OSW), and the Japan Institute of International Affairs. We hope to welcome many of you to the webinar.
