"The 2024 US Presidential Elections from Liberal and Conservative Perspectives"

The Japan Institute of International Affairs (JIIA) is pleased to announce that Glen S. 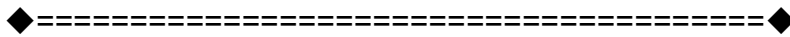
