

## The Significance of Universal Health Coverage (UHC) in Today's World from a SDGs Viewpoint and the Role of the United Nations

The Japan Institute of International Affairs (JIIA), the United Nations Information Centre, Tokyo and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (MOFA), with the support of the Japan Business Federation (Keidanren), will co-host an open webinar "The Significance of Universal Health Coverage (UHC) in Today's World from a SDGs Viewpoint and the Role of the United Nations".

This year will mark the 60th anniversary of Japan's universal health insurance system. The process by which UHC became an agenda item for the entire international community offers an excellent example of the synergistic effects produced when the UN's functions and Japan's efforts are combined.

In this webinar, experts will discuss UHC, the significance of which has garnered renewed attention during the coronavirus pandemic, from various perspectives such as SDGs, the UN's role, and Japan's health diplomacy initiatives.
